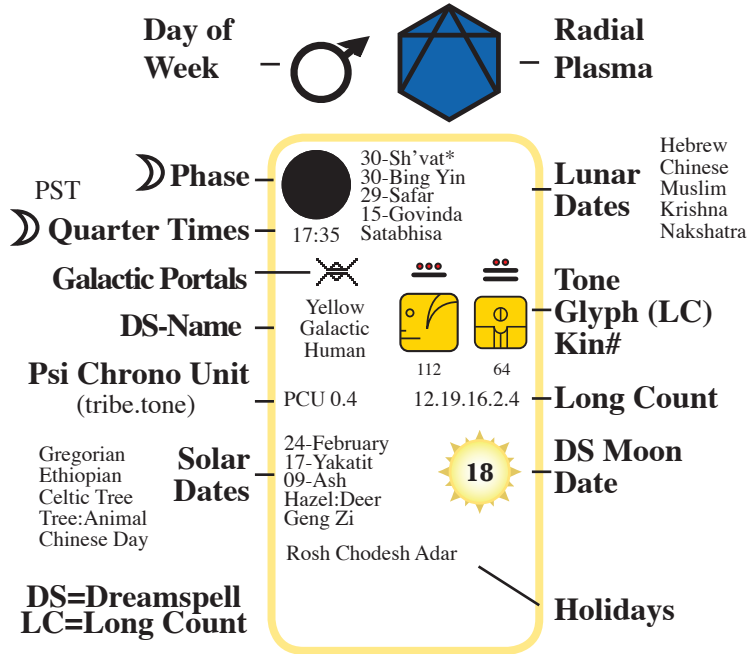

13 Moon Calendar: A New Harmonic Standard

The 13-Moon Calendar represents evolution in the mind regarding our understanding of time. Having months of the same length is valuable in seeing life from a balanced, equal perspective. The box on the right illustrates the layout of every moon (month). The 4x7 grid is constant. The 7 Radial Plasmas at the top are a new way of comprehending the 7-day cycle, because the traditional week days are named after the 7 Visible Planetary Satellites, Sun-Saturn. The 13-Moon Synchronometer uses the harmonic standard of seven to easily combine many of the different cultural time traditions.

Dreamspell Calendar: Connecting to the Galaxy

This calendar combines 13:20 Maya frequency with the 13-Moon Calendar, aligning the galactic, solar, and lunar cycles of the Earth in harmony. New Year for this calendar is July 26 (Gregorian), correlating with the heliacal rising of Sirius, the brightest and second-closest star to our Sun. The use of a galactic neighbor as a calibration point is unique for Earth calendars, as most start their new year based on the sun and moon.

Cycle of 13x20: The Maya Tzolkin

Tzolkin means "sacred count." The tzolkin matrix below, consists of a 13x20 grid, for a total of 260 days. This synchronic cycle has 52 (black) squares, known as galactic activation portals. These portals numerically unite Galactic time and Earth time.

Cycle of 7: Radial Plasmas and Visible Planetary Satellites



(Correlations between plasmas + planets change yearly)

The Dreamspell is a 365-day calendar. (13 months x 28 days + 1 = 365). The +1 is known as the Green Day, or Day-out-of-Time, and is not in one of the 13 Moons. It therefore has no weekly denomination of 1-7. The Green Day correlates to July 25 (Gregorian), and is for meditation and universal compassion. The Dreamspell calendar addresses leap years by adding 13-days every 52 years, which is known as the Solar-Galactic Cycle, during which the 365-day and 260-day cycles overlap. These 13-days are used for realignment to Spirit and also the recalibration of Earth to Sirius.
